NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS FROM JOHN DUNCAN- For many years Club has received monies from the Department of Wildlife for our services as hunting and fishing license agents for several stores and shops in the area. This is normally brought in approximately \$32,000 per year. We would then spend about \$16,000 per year on our youth programs and conservation programs to satisfy the state requirements that some of the money would be used on programs that would be of a benefit to the general public. The remainder was spent on maintaining our facilities and other programs as directed by the Officers and Trustees, with concurrence by the membership. We have recently been told by the Department of Wildlife that as of January 2010 this program will be changed and that a contractor hired by the state would service the license sellers throughout the state and our services would no longer be required. Our annual operating expenses are approximately \$21,000. We will need to generate this sum through dues and fund raisers. For this reason we are raising dues for 2009 to \$75 per year for general membership and \$50 per year senior and handicapped membership. This has been our first dues increase in almost 20 years. We are curtailing most of our public good programs for 2009 so as to try and get our budget in-line with our expected income. The youth programs will be funded and continued as these are important for future growth. If any of you have suggestions for fund raisers or any club functions please present your ideas at a meeting or contact one of the club trustees.

ANNUAL MEETING - Our annual Meeting will be held October 13 - we will be electing Officers & Trustees as well as voting on Administrative fund budgets and changes to the bylaws - All members are urged to attend.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE BY LAWS : These changes would be added to - Section 4 - Dues and Membership

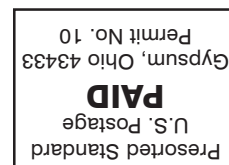
A. Club membership dues shall be determined at the Annual Meeting. Annual dues are seventy five dollars (\$75). Membership dues shall be levied on an annual basis with a one time only initiation fee of twenty dollars (\$20).

B. Members under the age of sixty five years shall pay the annual membership dues. Members who are sixty five and over shall pay fifty dollars (\$50) annual dues.

C. Disabled members shall pay fifty dollars (\$50) annual membership dues after submission of a copy of 100% disability from the Social Security Administration.
